Changing Your Major To ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING

Students planning to enter an engineering major or to change from one engineering major to another will be expected to complete at least 30 units at UCSB before petitioning for a change of major. Students normally must satisfy the prerequisites of the prospective major. Students who have completed more than 105 units will not be considered for a change of major/change of college in engineering or computer science. Students are expected to finish the degree requirements for the major in four years time from the start of matriculation at UCSB. Students may petition for a change of major when the requirements below have been met.

REQUIREMENTS

1. An overall UCSB grade point average of at least 3.0;

AND

2. Satisfactory completion at UCSB, with a grade point average of 3.0 or better, of <u>at least 5 classes</u>, including <u>at least two mathematics classes</u>, from the following:

Math 4B, Math 6A, Math 6B ECE 10A & 10AL - 10B & 10BL - 10C & 10CL ECE 15A

*The calculation of the minimum GPA will be based on all classes completed from this list at the time of petitioning.
