## **Changing Your Major To COMPUTER ENGINEERING**

Students planning to enter an engineering major or to change from one engineering major to another will be expected to complete at least 30 units at UCSB before petitioning for a change of major. Students normally must satisfy the prerequisites of the prospective major. Students who have completed more than 105 units will not be considered for a change of major/change of college in engineering or computer science. Students may petition for change of major when requirements below have been met.

## REQUIREMENTS

- **1.** An overall UCSB grade point average of at least 3.0;
  - AND
- Satisfactory completion at UCSB with a grade point average of 3.0 or better, of any five classes, including at least two Electrical & Computer Engineering (ECE) classes and two Computer Science (CMPSC) classes, from the following: Mathematics 4B; ECE 10A & ECE 10AL; ECE 10B & ECE 10BL; ECE 10C & ECE 10CL; ECE 15A; CMPSC 16, 24, 32, 40.
